Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC)	After you make your first premium payment.	This postcard tells you how to download your SBC, which is a plan summary we are required to share with you.
Web Registration Confirmation	After you register on anthem.com.	We'll mail you a letter after we see you've registered – just for security purposes.
