<p>Tools to Manage Health</p> 	<p>The Health & Wellness site on myuhc.com offers online health assessments, personal health records, online health coaching health trackers, to help members understand their lifestyle and health risks, and recommends preventive steps and programs to maintain or improve their health and reduce their risk.</p>
<p>Virtual Visits</p> 	<p>A secure, online 24-hour access to physicians using a mobile phone, tablet or computer. Members can receive a diagnosis and any necessary prescriptions for minor medical needs such as allergies, sinus and bladder infections, bronchitis and other conditions.</p>

<p>Confirmation Letter</p> 	<p>About 3 days after enrolling through Access Health CT.</p>	<p>Access Health CT will send you a letter confirming your enrollment.</p>
<p>First Bill</p> 	<p>About 5-7 days after you enroll.</p>	<p>You'll receive your first bill for your premium in the mail. At this time you will receive a temporary ID card. Activate it to access some of your health plan benefits and to be ready for use on your start date.</p> <p>You can pay by mail, phone or online. You can set up monthly automatic payments, too.</p> <p>Any financial help (subsidies) you receive is shown on your bill.</p>
<p>Member ID Card</p> 	<p>About 10 days after you pay your first bill.</p>	<p>Everyone covered by your plan will get an ID card in the mail.</p> <p>Cards say if you need a Primary Care Physician (PCP/ doctor) or referral.</p> <p>Show your ID card at doctor appointments and pharmacies.</p>
<p>Pharmacy and Provider Directories</p> 	<p>Directories are always available online at uhc.com/find-a-physician/xctchoiceplus.</p>	<p>The provider directories give you access to doctors, mental health professionals, pharmacy locations, hospitals and labs that are in your health plan's network.</p>
